Do The Teamsters Care About You or Your Money?

In March 2017, the Teamsters sought to make Sysco Columbia Drivers dues-paying members of the union. The Teamsters repeatedly harassed Drivers with unwelcome home visits – many of which while Drivers were working – leaving their families had to deal with the visitors.

The Teamsters filed an Unfair Labor Practice charge against Sysco Columbia on April 26, 2017, blocking the election 2 days before Drivers' ballots were to be counted (they had already cast their votes by mail). Sysco Columbia ultimately settled the charge to allow Drivers another secret ballot election.

The Teamsters were nowhere to be seen for years until shortly before the re-run election. Sysco Columbia Drivers sent the Teamsters **two** separate requests asking the Teamsters to withdraw the election petition because the Drivers didn't want the union, which the Teamsters ignored.

The re-run election was scheduled to be counted on November 3, 2021; however, confronted with Drivers' claims that the union would suffer an "embarrassing loss," the Teamsters withdrew their petition for an election on November 1.
